Assessment

- Clinical lead on assessments for the pan-London Family Drug and Alcohol Court team involving drug and/or alcohol use, physical and mental health, domestic violence, and complex systemic difficulties

Intervention

- Developing and monitoring interventions for alcohol and substance abuse difficulties, in addition to complex trauma, as Deputy Clinical Lead of the pan-London Family Drug and Alcohol Court team
- Providing specialist psychologist formulation and intervention for adults with moderate to severe depression, anxiety, trauma and personality disorders
- NICE guideline recommended treatment for a range of mental health difficulties including anxiety disorders and depression in children and adolescents
- Systemic interventions for attachment difficulties, developmental trauma, and parent-child relationships
